Thank you for your support for the Arkansas State Mission Project. You have given generously and you are to be commended. Please join me in prayer that more churches would join this ministry to help churches in the state of Arkansas and their mission works. I am praying for five new churches to begin helping this year. As a correction to last quarter's report, I need to add that the MBSF in Jonesboro sponsored by Grace MBC received a part of the Brotherhood Mutual dividend. The dividend funds were split five ways instead of four.

The third quarter funds have been split between Cornerstone MBC in El Paso and Landmark MBC in Clarksville. Each will receive a check for \$16,925.96. Bro. John Powers and Cornerstone MBC will use these funds to pay off property in Reynosa, Mexico where Bro. Oscar Rutiaga is serving as missionary, and they hope to begin building on this property in the new year. Landmark MBC in Clarksville is helping Bro. Edgar Rubio in Guamo, Columbia. Bro. Edgar is seeking to start an association of churches around the work in Guamo and these funds will help them build in Guamo. Bro. John Sanders and I were privileged to go to Guamo in August and see the work. First Baptist is excited to be able to help these works and thank you for making this possible.

The fourth quarter funds will go to help Budd Creek camp finish a building project. Remember Bro. Reggie and Sis. Miranda and Lucas as they continue to work there. The first quarter funds will go to Summit MBC in Pine Bluff. They have purchased 7.74 acres in Springdale. Pray for Bro. Todd Anderson and Bro. Micah Deaton and all these works mentioned, their families, and the people they work with for the Lord. I look forward to seeing those who will be in Jonesboro for the Arkansas state meeting in November.
