Medical Mission, Brother Nelson Mugmal and his wife were in charge of the work; currently Brother Nelson is pastor at the Lamb of God Baptist Missionary Church in the Naranjito community and Brother Alexander Mugmal is in charge of the new church.

The church of Pinsaqui is ready to start the construction of the temple; the access road to the land has already been opened and the ideas have been drawn up; thank you to Centerpoint's Landmark MBC and Pastor Steve Jacobs for their love and support of this church.
