We're also taking important steps in forming the translation team. As we wait for baby Malachi's passport and visa, we're using this season to review what we've learned and try to plan well for the next stage. Thank you for praying with us through each step of this process!

The Beauty of Language

God is amazing and creative. The languages of the world contain an incredible diversity of structures and grammar. That's why it's so important to really learn and study a language and how it works when doing translation.

Let me give you a taste of the Murkim language to show what I mean. If you want to say, "I hit a mouse with a hammer," in Murkim you would say: "Nuk hama kun ya kena arbe blo ko." This translates quite literally as "I hammer grab mouse hit."

In Indonesian, you would say "Saya memukul seekor tikus dengan palu," which literally means "I hit a mouse with hammer." As you can see, the structure in Murkim is very different from both English and Indonesian. So if you were translating this sentence from English or Indonesian into Murkim, you couldn't just translate it word for word. You'd need to understand the grammar, structure, and natural phrasing of Murkim to express the same idea correctly. Thank you for praying for us as we learn the Murkim language.
