


Pinsaqui - Ecuador

Construction of the church in Guamo is progressing!!! Brother Edgar estimates the cost of construction of the new church to be about \$150,000.00. As of 12/2/2025 we have sent \$123,960 for the church building project. We trust God for His provision.

We are now moving forward with the church building project at Pinsaqui, Ecuador. The property was purchased several years ago. Building plans have been purchased (400) and initial funds have been sent (10,000) to begin construction. Initials road work and dirt work has begun

We thank God for His blessings and for His provision and for the souls that were saved and for the seeds that were planted. We thank all of the churches and individuals that have prayed and supported Brother Edgar in his ministry It is amazing to see the hand of God working and His provision.
